IRAC is proud to be one of the few Jewish religious organizations that advocates for full equality and inclusion in all spheres of Israeli society.

Many legal precedents that have led to Israel being known globally as LGBTQ-friendly have been through the work of IRAC, including:

- Securing public monies from the Municipality of Jerusalem to fund the Jerusalem Open House, and in turn using the precedent to fund LGBTQ services in other cities
- Offering legal and financial support to Jerusalem's annual March for Pride and Tolerance
- Establishing equal rights for all immigrants in same-sex couples
- Providing common-law partners and same-sex couples with equal access to parenthood through adoption
- Monitoring and bringing lawsuits against public figures who promote homophobia and incite against LGBTQ citizens
- Advocating for an end to the Rabbinate's monopoly over marriage and divorce, and to extend equal rights in Israel for same-sex couples
